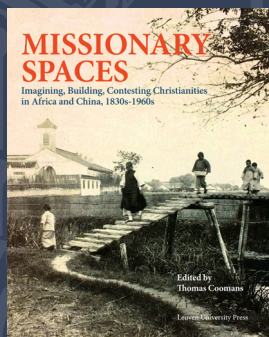
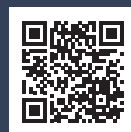


KADOC-ARTES

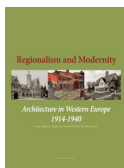
